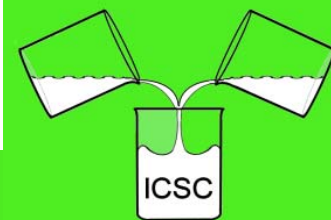


# 33<sup>rd</sup> International Conference on *Solution Chemistry*
